


History of United Church of Christ Congregational Friend, Nebraska The First Congregational Church was organized on June 15, 1875, in Friendville, by Mr. and Mrs. J. Harrison, Mr. and Mrs. H. Moeller, Mr. and Mrs. A. Paine and Mr. H. Harrison. The first church services were held in a local schoolhouse.

In October, 1877, construction was begun on the first church, and while the building was being constructed the congregation worshiped in the Frantz and Brickly Hall. The church was dedicated in December of 1880, and in 1881 and 1883 additions of a bell tower and prayer room were added to the building.

By 1901 the congregation had outgrown the original building and it was decided to build a new church. The old structure was moved west and is now the present chapel. A new Sanctuary and basement were added onto the original building, and the church was dedicated in 1902.

In 1965, the council began discussing, studying and planning toward the building of a new structure. At the annual meeting held on January 7, 1973, it was unanimously voted to raise funds for a new structure and to start construction when 80 percent of the goal had been reached.
